Denver City Senior Activity Center

Level 5 design group, as the design-build group on this project, completed this 9,300 sq ft building at the end of 2015. The Denver City Senior Activity Center is a valuable addition to the community of Denver City, TX. The exterior facade ties into the adjacent Shinnery Oaks Community with exterior brickwork to act as an extension of the existing Senior Center community. It provides two mid-size classrooms, seating 18 people each, with the option to combine the two spaces with an

electric removeable partition wall. It also has a one large banquet hall, seating over 175 comfortably in tables and chairs, where lunch will be served weekly and for special events from a full size commercial kitchen and scullery. In addition, it has a small office for private staff and a conference room for public use. The facility is complete with the use of timeless interior colors and finishes.
